

MEETING OUTCOME

A statutory board established under the Gaming and Liquor Administration Act 2007

The Independent Liquor & Gaming Authority (ILGA) held a meeting of its Liquor & Gaming Committee on **Wednesday**, **30 May 2022** to consider applications under the *Liquor Act 2007 and Gaming Machines Act 2001*. The next ILGA Liquor & Gaming Committee meeting is scheduled for **Wednesday**, **15 June 2022**.

ILGA considered the following matters and the status of each matter is listed below.

Liquorland, Helensburgh – Application for a packaged liquor licence <i>[matter carried over from a previous meeting]</i>	Refused
Seaview Tavern, Woolgoolga – Request to revoke approval of a Class 1 Local Impact Assessment	Refused

Definitions:

Approved – The application has been approved. The approval may be subject to conditions or provision of certain information.

Partially approved – The application has been partially approved, for example authorising less extensive trading hours or licensed area than what the applicant sought.

Refused – The application has been rejected.

Under consideration – The matter is yet to be determined. A decision will be published once finalised.

Determined – This disciplinary matter or review application has been considered and determined by the ILGA board, with decisions to be published where applicable.

Not considered – The matter was not considered by ILGA at this meeting.

Withdrawn – The application has been withdrawn.

Invalid - The application has been deemed invalid.
