The instructions below must be completed **within two working days** of lodging an application with the Independent Liquor & Gaming Authority.

Follow these instructions carefully. Failure to comply with all requirements may result in rejection of your application.

Public Consultation - Site Notice

- ☐ Sign and date the public consultation - site notice, which is attached and pre-completed.
- ☐ A **copy** of the completed and signed notice:
 - ☐ **Must** be affixed to the **location of the proposed licensed premises**.
 - If the premises are yet to be built, the notice must be affixed to a noticeboard erected on the land, and must be protected from weather.
 - If the premises are already erected, the notice should be placed on the inside of an exterior glass window or door.
 - The notice must be legible to members of the public passing the premises or land, and should be facing onto the street that is most likely to be used by passers-by. It should be placed between 1.5 and 2 metres above ground, so it is easily read by a passing adult.
 - ***The notice must remain continuously affixed at the location until the application is determined by the Authority.***
 - ☐ **Must** be provided to the **occupiers of surrounding buildings** (unless the application is for a producer/wholesaler licence. However, if a drink on premises authorisation has been lodged in addition to a producer/wholesaler, you must notify all neighbouring premises.) This means:
 - any building or land adjoining the licensed premises, regardless of a separating road.
 - any building on land situated within 50 metres of the boundary of the proposed licensed premises, or, if a CIS category B is required, on land situated within 100 metres of the boundary.
 - ☐ Where applicable, **must** be provided to:
 - the local council or other consent authority for a neighbouring local government area (LGA) if the proposed licensed premises are within 500 metres of the other LGA.
 - the Crown Lands division of NSW Trade & Investment, if the proposed licensed premises are on Crown Land.
 - ☐ **Must** be provided to all **stakeholders** consulted during the Community Impact Statement (CIS) process, *if a CIS was required for the application.*
