

## NOTICE OF MEETING

The Independent Liquor & Gaming Authority (ILGA) will hold an extraordinary board meeting on **12 October 2023** following the Whitebull appeal decision regarding certain gaming machine matters (20 September). In addition to the initially deferred liquor and gaming application matters, ILGA will also consider a number of additional liquor and gaming applications.
