Organisation	Donation	Purpose of Donation
Margaret Druitt Day Care Centre	\$5,858	Margaret Druitt Day Centre is a long day centre looking after the community welfare of families who struggle for affordable long day care for their children. To purchase educational resources for enrolled children aged 2 to 5 years at Margaret Day Care Centre.
UNSW Soccer Club	\$15,000	To fund sports-based leadership program called "Creating Changes" for vulnerable youth. These youth will be mentored and coached by the 'graduates' of Football United's leadership program.
Marist Youth Care	\$27,247	To fund an educational scholarship fund that provides educational equipment to assist young people to complete their education.
Rotary Club of Blacktown City Inc	\$5,000	To fund projects in; a PhD research scholarship into chronic kidney disease and to build a kitchen in an orphanage for former children soldiers in Monrovia and Liberia that caters to 42 orphans.
R.O.S.E Charity Inc	\$7,734	Monies to assist students at William Rose School with the purchase of an 8 seater vehicle. This new vehicle will be used to take students to community access programs, work experience, educational excursions and sporting programs.
Delta Society Australia Ltd	\$3,500	Monies will be used to recruit and train therapy dogs. Delta Society has a current waitlist for over 200 therapy dogs and operates 5 services in the Blacktown LGA.
Graceades Community Cottage	\$23,000	Funding will be used at the Willmot Men's Shed to buy materials and fund a facilitator to work with the men one or two days a week. The Men's Shed Program provides support and services to isolated men in the Blacktown LGA.
Parramatta Nepean Presbytery Uniting Church Aust	\$4,377	To fund their Circles Program which equips families and the community to thrive and end poverty.
Philippine Australia Community Services Inc (PACSI)	\$3,600	Funds to work with Filipino migrants including case management, referrals, information sessions, and activities to break social isolation.
SHINE for kids co-operative Ltd	\$22,704	Donation will provide 88 children with a parent in prison from the Blacktown LGA to attend their drop in centres. The centres also provide assistance to families and teenagers to debrief after a prison visit and discuss concerns about their children and available options to them.
Fitted for Work	\$10,000	The donations will be used to prepare women for the work force with Fit for Work Interview, Presentation and Preparation Workshops.
Mt Druitt Street University (Noffs Foundation)	\$29,040	Funds will be used to increase the projects of the Ted Noffs Foundation, including the Mt Druitt Street University.
Guide Dogs Australia	\$10,000	Funding will be used towards a community educational program for the indigenous community, raising awareness about vision impairment, prevention and services available for people with vision loss.
Wesley Mission	\$11,731	Donation will fund three (3) highly disadvantaged children in the Blacktown area to link with a fully trained volunteer.
Royal Life Saving Society NSW Branch	\$9,600	Funds will be used to provide one hundred (100) Year 10 students the opportunity to complete First Aid Training at no cost to the student. Students will also receive a First Aid in A Box and token codes to complete on-line learning modules.
Blacktown Youth Services Association	\$46,100	Funds will be used to facilitate a number of programs that are targeted to some of Blacktown's most at risk and disadvantaged young people. The two main groups are 'Savvy' a girls only group and 'Brotherhood' a boys mentoring program.
Autism Spectrum Australia (Aspect)	\$8,800	Donation will be used to purchase updated technology (IPads and laptops) for high school students with autism in the Blacktown LGA.
MS Australia	\$6,250	Funds will be used to support local families during their life long journey with MS. Monies will also be used for their range of programs that offer assessments, literature, Teleconferencing, seminars and face to face support on MS issues.
Starlight Children's Foundation	\$6,500	Monies will be used to grant five (5) children in the Blacktown LGA with a wish. A wish on average costs \$6,500 and since 1988 has granted 8,700 starlight wishes.
WentWest Limited	\$9,400	The donation will be used towards running a Blacktown Diabetes Support Group. The group will be identified from GP clinics, hospital and the general public.
