A statutory board established under the Gaming and Liquor Administration Act 2007

The Independent Liquor and Gaming Authority (ILGA) held a board meeting on **Wednesday, 14 March 2018** to consider, among other things, applications under the *Gaming and Liquor Administration Act 2007, Casino Control Act 1992, Liquor Act 2007, Gaming Machines Act 2001 and Registered Clubs Act 1976.* The next ILGA board meeting is scheduled for **Wednesday, 11 April 2018.**

Definitions:

Determined – This disciplinary matter or review application has been considered and determined by the ILGA board, with decisions to be published where applicable.

Not considered – The matter was not considered by the ILGA board at this meeting.
