

ILGA CIRCULAR: 11 SEP 2019

APPROVED NSW Technical Standards: 'GM Banknote Acceptor Limit' Change

Introduction

The ClubsNSW MOU with the NSW Government of 13 October 2018 provides a commitment such that the gaming machine cash input limit is to be reduced from \$7,500 to **\$5,000**.

This circular released by the Independent Liquor and Gaming Authority (the Authority) facilitates this commitment by approving a change to the Authority's approved technical standards in accordance with the *Gaming Machines Act 2001*, section 62 'approval of technical standards for gaming machines'.

TECHNICAL STANDARDS CHANGES

The following technical standard change will come into effect on **1 MAY 2020** for all approvals issued (except for bug fixes). This change can be adopted earlier if so desired:

Gaming Machine National Standard (2016 section 11.2):

BKNTLIM: \$5,000 – GMs must stop accepting tickets, coins, notes and CCCE transfers when a limit is reached.

NSW Appendix (2016):

2.3.1: CCCE-in \$5,000

NSW Jackpot Standard ver 1.3:

2.2.14: CCCE limit = \$5,000

NSW Systems Submission Checklist

Line of Sight: CCCE In (to EGM) = \$5,000

The new parameter value limit must be hard-coded.

Approved gaming machines currently operating in the field are not affected by this circular.
