

MEETING OUTCOME

A statutory board established under the Gaming and Liquor Administration Act 2007

The Independent Liquor & Gaming Authority (ILGA) held a board meeting on **Wednesday**, **14 October 2020** to consider, among other things, applications under the *Gaming and Liquor Administration Act 2007*, *Casino Control Act 1992*, *Liquor Act 2007*, *Gaming Machines Act 2001* and the *Registered Clubs Act 1976*. The next ILGA board meeting is scheduled for **Wednesday**, **11 November 2020**.
