

## MEETING OUTCOME

The Independent Liquor & Gaming Authority (ILGA) held a board meeting on **Wednesday, 16 December 2020** to consider, among other things, applications under the *Gaming and Liquor Administration Act 2007*, *Casino Control Act 1992*, *Liquor Act 2007*, *Gaming Machines Act 2001* and the *Registered Clubs Act 1976*. The next ILGA board meeting is scheduled for **Wednesday 20 January 2021**.

**Not considered** – The matter was not considered by ILGA at this meeting.

**Withdrawn** – The application has been withdrawn.

**Invalid** – The application has been deemed invalid.
