The Independent Liquor and Gaming Authority (ILGA) will hold its next board meeting on **Wednesday, 11 April 2018** in Sydney, NSW. Following the closure of the public and/or stakeholder consultation processes, the following matters, amongst other things, have been listed for consideration by the ILGA board:

## **Casino regulation**
