

## **MEETING OUTCOME**

A statutory board established under the Gaming and Liquor Administration Act 2007

The Independent Liquor & Gaming Authority (ILGA) held a meeting of its Liquor & Gaming Committee on **Wednesday**, **13 April 2022** to consider, among other things, applications under the *Gaming and Liquor Administration Act 2007, Liquor Act 2007, Gaming Machines Act 2001* and the *Registered Clubs Act 1976*. The next ILGA Liquor & Gaming Committee meeting is scheduled for **Wednesday 18 May 2022**.

## Definitions:

*Not considered* – The matter was not considered by ILGA at this meeting.

*Withdrawn* – The application has been withdrawn.

*Invalid* – The application has been deemed invalid.
