

MEETING OUTCOME

A statutory board established under the Gaming and Liquor Administration Act 2007

The Independent Liquor & Gaming Authority (ILGA) held a board meeting on **Wednesday**, **16 June 2021** to consider, among other things, applications under the *Gaming and Liquor Administration Act 2007, Casino Control Act 1992, Liquor Act 2007, Gaming Machines Act 2001* and the *Registered Clubs Act 1976*. The next ILGA board meeting is scheduled for **Wednesday 14 July 2021**.

ILGA considered the following matters and the status of each matter is listed below.

Not considered – The matter was not considered by ILGA at this meeting.

Withdrawn – The application has been withdrawn.

Invalid – The application has been deemed invalid.
