LOCAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT (CLASS 1)**

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

- Western Suburbs League Club (Campbelltown) Ltd (“West’s”) will operate a new Registered Club known as The Greens Gledswood Hills (“the Club”), which is located in the Camden Local Government Area (LGA), classified as in Band 2 by the Independent Liquor and Gaming Authority as part of the *Gaming Machines Amendment Act 2008 No 99*. As such, a Class 1 Local Impact Assessment in a Band 2 LSA is submitted requesting a poker machine threshold increase of 20 poker machines.
- The Club currently has a gaming machine threshold of 0, thus an increase of 20 poker machines would bring this total to 20.
- An increase of 20 poker machines would result in a variety of positive outcomes for NSW and particularly Camden and the surrounding area.
- As this is a new Registered Club we cannot use the calculation of *15% of average profit of existing gaming machines before tax x GMT increase x 5 years* as there are no gaming machines to use in the calculation. The Club is prepared to make financial contributions of \$10,000 per year for five years to the Responsible Gambling Fund.

West’s has a proven record of contributing well in excess of its legal obligation via Clubgrants of providing financial support to many charity and sporting groups within the Macarthur Region and has no intention of changing this genuine approach.

- The Club will adhere to all harm minimisation and responsible gambling measures stipulated in the *Gaming Machines Regulation 2002* and the *Gaming Machines Act 2001*. Furthermore, West’s has adopted the Clubs NSW *Registered Clubs Responsible Conduct of Gambling Code of Practice – Best Practice Guidelines* principles and is a member of the *BetSafe* Responsible Gambling Program.
- The Club has a serious commitment to responsible gaming and ensures all gaming staff complete a Liquor Administration Board approved Responsible Conduct of Gambling course.
- The Club provides a voluntary pre commitment system, so all members may set their own maximum spend limits. This is a very serious investment to address harm minimisation.
- The venue is not in the immediate vicinity of a school, place of worship or hospital **(Attachment A)**
