



A statutory board established under the Gaming and Liquor Administration Act 2007

The Independent Liquor & Gaming Authority (ILGA) held a board meeting on **Wednesday, 14 July 2021** to consider, among other things, applications under the *Gaming and Liquor Administration Act 2007*, *Casino Control Act 1992*, *Liquor Act 2007*, *Gaming Machines Act 2001* and the *Registered Clubs Act 1976*. The next ILGA board meeting is scheduled for **Wednesday 11 August 2021**.

ILGA considered the following matters and the status of each matter is listed below.

**Under consideration** – The matter is yet to be determined. A decision will be published once finalised.

**Determined** – This disciplinary matter or review application has been considered and determined by the ILGA board, with decisions to be published where applicable.

**Not considered** – The matter was not considered by ILGA at this meeting.

**Withdrawn** – The application has been withdrawn.

**Invalid** – The application has been deemed invalid.
