## **Definitions:**

*Approved* – The application has been approved. The approval may be subject to conditions or provision of certain information.

*Partially approved* – The application has been partially approved, for example authorising less extensive trading hours or licensed area than what the applicant sought.

Refused – The application has been rejected.

*Under consideration* – The matter is yet to be determined. A decision will be published once finalised.

**Determined** – This disciplinary matter or review application has been considered and determined by the ILGA board, with decisions to be published where applicable.

Not considered – The matter was not considered by ILGA at this meeting.

*Withdrawn* – The application has been withdrawn.

Invalid – The application has been deemed invalid.
