

Notice of Development Application

INFORMATION

Purpose

Notification should be provided to Police and the Director General of NSW Trade & Investment (the Director General) **within 2 working days** of any Development Application (DA), or any amendment to an in-progress DA (amendment), that relates to a small bar liquor licence.

A community impact statement (CIS) will need to be submitted with the licence application if the notification has not been provided within two working days of DA or amendment. A CIS helps determine the likely impact and level of community support for the proposal.

Cost

There is no cost to lodge this notice.

Lodgement with Local police (Required)

Lodge this notification at the police station nearest to the premises for the small bar.

Lodgement with Director General (Required)

Do not mail this notification as this will delay receipt.
