COMMUNITY DROP-IN SESSIONS ON CALLINAN REVIEW OF NSW LIQUOR LAWS

Liquor & Gaming NSW is holding community drop-in sessions to help people find out more about the Hon Ian Callinan AC QC's independent statutory review of the state's liquor laws.

The review, which the NSW Government released on Tuesday 13 September immediately after receiving it, has made findings and conclusions on laws including 1.30am lockouts and 3am last drinks in Kings Cross and the Sydney CBD.

The drop-in sessions are a chance for people to learn more about the report from Liquor & Gaming NSW senior staff.
