# Correction of an administrative error in a decision dated 7 April 2017

I refer to the decision dated 7 April 2017 imposing conditions on the license of Oatlands House Restaurant, Oatlands, under section 81 of the *Liquor Act 2007*.

It has come to my attention that the decision included an administrative error in the transcription of the condition relating to the installation of a noise limiter. It was intended that the condition only apply to that part of the licensed premises currently known as the Garden Suite or the Garden Ballroom.

As such I have determined to correct the error. The correction is set out in Annexure 1 to this letter. You should note that this correction supersedes the noise limiter condition set out in the decision of 7 April 2017 and is effective immediately. This change does not materially change the decision and the other condition imposed does not change. The license will be updated in due course and you will be provided with a copy.

### **Noise Limiter**

At all times when amplified entertainment is conducted in that part of the premises known as the Garden Suite or Garden Ballroom, the licensee must ensure all amplifiers or noise generating equipment is under the control of a noise limiter.

- a. The noise limiter levels must be set by an acoustic engineer; and,
- b. The noise limiter controller must be contained within a locked container or secure area and is to be only accessible by venue management.
