

## What this form is for

To allow hotels and registered clubs that have issued gaming machine tickets which have now expired, to repay the value of the tickets to the Secretary, Department of Industry, within three months after they have expired under clause 114 (3) of the Gaming Machine Regulation 2010. 'Expired' gaming machine tickets are tickets that have not been redeemed within 12 months of being issued.

**Note:** You may have to pay a penalty of up to \$5,500 if you fail to submit this payment to the Secretary by the due date.
