- the general reputation of the applicant having regard to character, honesty and integrity.

- 3. This form is to be completed in English. Any documents which are required to be provided and which are in a language other than English, are to have a certified English translation appended.

- 5. If you are required to be finger and palm printed, you will be given instructions from your employer on how to arrange this with your local Police force.
