What this form is for

If you have had a gaming machine threshold increase approved by the Independent Liquor & Gaming Authority (ILGA), where a local impact assessment (LIA) was not required, you are now required to inform local community organisations, your local council and local government agencies of your gaming machine threshold increase.

You only need to complete this form **after** ILGA has approved an increase to your gaming machine threshold.

You must within one month, inform local community organisations, local council, local government agencies and local police of your gaming machine threshold increase. Failing to inform these bodies may affect your threshold.

Note

You must notify the following organisations that your gaming machine threshold has increased:

Local community organisations

- ▲ the NSW Council of Social Service

This also includes local community organisations, as listed by your local council for the area in which your venue is situated, that provide the local community services relating to:

- ▲ welfare
- ▲ emergency relief
- ▲ financial assistance
- ▲ Aboriginal health
- ▲ Aboriginal legal assistance
- ▲ any organisation in the Local Government Area (LGA) that receives funding from the Responsible Gambling Fund to provide gambling-related counselling or treatment services

Local government agencies

- ▲ the Local Health District for the area where the venue is situated
- ▲ your local council
- ▲ your local Police

- ▲ Local council
- ▲ Local government agencies

Part 3 – Gaming machine threshold increase

A venue's Gaming Machine Threshold sets the maximum number of Gaming Machine Entitlements that a venue may hold. Each Gaming Machine Entitlement allows the venue to operate one gaming machine. In most cases a portion of any Gaming Machine Entitlements transferred to this venue as a result of this increase in Gaming Machine Threshold will be forfeited to the Government and permanently removed from circulation, reducing the overall number of gaming machines available in NSW.
