Gaming Machine Entitlement Transfer – Rural Hotel Gaming Closure – With Gaming Machine Threshold Increase

What this form is for

This application is for a hotel that is applying to increase their gaming machine threshold (GMT) in order to buy (transfer) gaming machine entitlements (GMEs), without forfeiture, from a country hotel with a gaming machine threshold of 6 or less that with this (and any related transfer applications) will be reducing to zero gaming machine entitlements, and no Local Impact Assessment is required.

What you need to know

If you will be increasing the availability of gaming after midnight you may be captured by Guideline 16 - Late-night gaming applications, which sets out additional factors that the Independent Liquor & Gaming Authority may consider when reviewing applications involving late-night gaming.

Under section 36 of the *Gaming and Liquor Administration Act 2007* and section 307A of the *Crimes Act 1900* it is an offence to provide false or misleading information in this application.

A country hotel may transfer no more than 6 gaming machine entitlements to the city in any 12 month period.

This form is for hotels that are seeking to increase their gaming machine threshold and do not need to submit a local impact assessment (LIA).

You do not need to submit an LIA if:

- You are seeking a threshold increase to accommodate gaming machine entitlements that are to be transferred to your venue from another venue in your SA2 and you lodge your threshold increase application with the GME transfer application
- You are seeking a threshold increase to accommodate gaming machine entitlements that are to be transferred to your venue from another venue in your LGA, that venue is in a SA2 of the same or higher Band than your venue's SA2 and you lodge your threshold increase application with the GME transfer application
- ▲ You are seeking a threshold increase to accommodate gaming machine entitlements that are to be transferred to your venue from another venue in a SA2 directly bordering your venues SA2, that venue's SA2 is of the same or higher Band than your venue's SA2 and you lodge your threshold increase application with the GME transfer application.
- Your venue is in a Band 1 SA2, you lodge your threshold increase application with an application to transfer GMEs to your venue, and the GMT increase sought plus any other increases granted to you over the last 12 months is 20 or less.

Note

A Class 1 LIA is required for hotels seeking a threshold increase of:

- ▲ up to 30 in a Band 1 SA2
- ▲ up to 20 in a Band 2 SA2

A Class 2 LIA is required for hotels seeking a threshold increase of:

▲ more than 20 in a Band 2 SA2

Explanation of terms

Term Applicant	Definition The person or organisation qualified to make this application. The applicant may nominate a legal or other representative to be their contact person regarding this application.
Gaming machine	A gaming machine, also known as a poker machine or a 'pokie', is an electronic device designed for gambling.
Gaming machine entitlement / poker machine permits	A venue must hold a gaming machine entitlement (GME) or poker machine permit (PMP) (hotels only) for each gaming machine operated.
Gaming machine threshold	The gaming machine threshold (GMT) is a number which limits how many gaming machine entitlements (GMEs), and for hotels, poker machine permits (PMPs) – that a club or hotel licence can hold. A venue must have a GME or PMP for each gaming machine operated. A hotel's GMT cannot exceed 30.
Local impact assessment	A local impact assessment (LIA) may be required when a hotel or registered club applies to increase its gaming machine threshold to operate more gaming machines, or where a hotel or club changes location.
LIA public register	Details of determined and pending local impact assessments are available on the LIA public register on the L&GNSW website. The register contains a a list of LIAs that clubs and hotels have lodged, together with an application to increase the GMT.
