
LOCAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT RED COW HOTEL 9 STATION STREET, PENRITH LICENCE NUMBER: H400119011

The Red Cow Hotel is located in a Band 2 LGA in the CBD of Penrith opposite Penrith Railway Station.



There are no schools, places of public worship or hospitals within the immediate vicinity.

The average age of the area is 34 with a median weekly household income of \$1,400. 42% of households have a mortgage and 26% of households rent. 2.8% of residents are Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islanders and 29.5% of these are one parent families.

The Red Cow Hotel is a member of the Australian Hotels Association (who provide a gambling counselling service) and the Penrith/St Marys Liquor Accord. As part of the FAL Hotels group, we have in place strict procedures relating to the gaming machines and adhere to the Austrac guidelines for Anti-Money Laundering and Counter-Terrorism Financing Act 2006 and the Anti-Money Laundering and Counter-Terrorism Financing Rules Instrument 2007 (No.1).

The Red Cow Hotel would provide a \$25,000 donation to Wentworth Community Housing Limited if the additional gaming machines are approved.

Wentworth Community Housing Limited is a not-for-profit company that provides affordable, rental housing and other assistance to eligible people who are on low to moderate incomes.

They have a specialised Aboriginal team that aims to assist in bridging cultural and communication differences by providing advice, support, assistance in accessing support services and addressing homelessness.

In addition to the above, Wentworth Community Housing Limited also offer an assertive outreach program whereby the workers visit rough sleepers on their home turf to encourage them to take the first steps towards permanent housing and emergency housing for women and children of domestic violence.
