THE TRADITION OF TWO-UP

Minister for Racing Paul Toole has reminded licensed venues to observe the rules of two-up during Anzac Day events tomorrow.

“Two-up is a time-honoured Australian tradition and a great opportunity for revelers to get together at their local pub or club and commemorate the Anzac spirit,” Mr Toole said.

“Anzac Day is one of three days a year this game can be played in NSW outside of Broken Hill and while venues don’t need a permit, they are encouraged to fully understand and observe the traditional rules of two-up and patrons are reminded to always gamble responsibly.”

Mr Toole said NSW pubs and clubs are committed to making sure Anzac Day is an enjoyable and safe day for all.

“With large crowds expected at venues across the State, it is important licensees monitor patron alcohol consumption and behaviour on Anzac Day to avoid intoxication and any anti-social behaviour.

“Liquor & Gaming NSW will also be conducting inspections of licensed premises on Anzac Day to ensure compliance with liquor and gaming laws with a focus on the responsible service of alcohol.”
