### **REVIEW SUPPORTS THE STAR CONTINUING TO OPERATE CASINO LICENCE**

The NSW Independent Liquor and Gaming Authority has publicly issued its five-yearly review of The Star which has found the operator is suitable to continue running the casino.

Authority chair Philip Crawford said the Section 31 review under the Casino Control Act has also made several recommendations for improving The Star's operations.

"The authority will be discussing these recommendations with the operator in coming weeks," Mr Crawford said.

"It is a legislative requirement that the authority undertake regular investigations into the casino operator's suitability at least every five years.

"The review, by Jonathan Horton QC, has found:

- The casino operator is a suitable person to continue to give effect to the casino licence
- It is in the public interest that the casino should continue in force."
