FREE WORKSHOPS FOR HUNTER REGION LICENSED VENUE STAFF

Hunter Region licensed venue staff are invited to free workshops to find out all the latest information on liquor legislation and refresh their knowledge of responsible service of alcohol requirements.

The workshops at the Grain Store in Newcastle East on **Monday 26 June** will help hospitality workers improve their customer service skills and avoid alcohol-related harm.

Topics covered in the two-hour sessions include measures to prevent intoxication, identifying risk factors in venues and detecting minors and fake IDs.

There will also be briefings on recent legislative changes.

The workshops are presented by Liquor & Gaming NSW in partnership with the Newcastle CBD Liquor Accord.
