I think liberal licences for small bars will create the same problem which led to the lockouts.

Very small businesses disappear to franchising and syndications. The same corporations will own the small bars and run promotions that entice customers to their other bars up the road. Thus we will have the street used as a thoroughfare for drunks and in this sense the street will be used as a businesses means of production.

Drunks will still still be barred entry and will wander around trying to get into all the other small bars. Male security and door people will be centrally planned and on walkie talkies, calling ahead to let this or that group in or out, like they run the street.
