Re: Lockout Review

I mainly work evenings, and when socialising with friends am unable to get out to until around 11.30pm (after eating, showering etc).

The lockouts have had a real impact on my ability to unwind and enjoy the city, both in nightclubs and in my ability to pick up a bottle of wine after a night at work.

It makes me upset that other, younger people, that I work with are unable to enjoy themselves the way I did in my early twenties due to the lockouts themselves and the bar closures that have happened since.

Regarding violence, I've had extensive experience spending nights out in Kings Cross and along Oxford St - and would like to state that, in all those years, I've never seen real violent behavior.

I'd like to remind the members of the review that anecdotes, which inspired the lockouts, is not the singular of data - and data overwhelmingly shows that the lockouts have had no net effect on violence in the city.

I hope you decide to save Sydney for young people, before that damage becomes irreversible.
