In relation to liquor laws that require the delivery of alcohol to stop at 10pm. we would like, respectfully, to point out that in our view any system that confines alcohol consumers to remain indoors while they drink, is a relief to those of us who would rather be spared from being confronted by them outside. We say this without prejudice to those who drink responsibly; however, unfortunately, such groups seem to be getting smaller. With this in mind we feel that such companies as Jimmy Brings are actually doing a service to the public without inconveniencing anybody, irrespective of the time that the alcohol is delivered. Given Sydney's society it is most likely that most of the alcohol, particularly on weekends, is consumed after 10pm rather than earlier.
