My name is Sarah Cherny and I am a thirty-two-year-old mother of two children living in Bellevue Hill. I am writing in reference to the independent review being conducted on the impact of liquor law reforms.

My husband and I regularly use a service called **Jimmy Brings** which is an alcohol delivery service which has been impacted by the 10pm cut off for the sale of alcohol.

Since having children we much prefer to entertain friends at home rather than pay expensive babysitting fees to go out to restaurants and bars. We have used Jimmy Brings on a number of occasions when we have run out of wine while having dinner with friends. This service creates a safe platform for people to drink in the comfort of their homes rather than be out on the street or in busy, loud bars and most importantly avoids any temptation or risk that someone may get in the car to go to the bottle shop. The delivery of alcohol certainly ensures less people out at night, intoxicated in bars and clubs, which in turn surely results in less problematic behaviour and alcohol fuelled violence.

My friends and I are much happier drinking a glass or two of wine at home. Jimmy Brings is a service in line with a safer and more dignified drinking culture and the 10pm cut off should be lifted.
