Hi,

I am the director of Shield Security Services. I have been working in the Kings Cross area since 2012 for every weekend and so has my security business (we are currently still situated there).

My company had the majority of the venues in Kings Cross such as;

1. Trademark - closed down
2. Whaat Club (next to Candys) - closed down
3. Village - closed down
4. Sapphire - closed down
5. Club 21/Vintage - closed down
6. The Bank Hotel - closed down
7. The Tunnel - closed down
8. Backroom - closed down
9. Dreamgirls - no more liquor licence
10. Candys
11. The Club
12. New Hampton
13. DejaVu - closed down
14. The Kings Cross Patrol - ceased operation
15. Showgirls

As you can see only 4 venues remaining need my security services.

The lockout law has reduced my services hours by at least 40% to almost 50% due to the following factors;

- Reduced trading hours
- Reduced trading days
- Reduced number of venues in the district.

Due to some venues closing and not having a ability to pay there invoices, i had to work a full time day job in accounting office and work majority of weeknights and every weekend to make sure my employees get paid.

As i have said before i have worked every weekend in Kings Cross since early 2012 and i have had experience with trouble makers who have been intoxicated or not. If you need any information to assist with the review i am more the happy to assist.
