To The Honorable Ian Callinan AC QC,

It has come to my attention that you are conducting an independent review of liquor Licencing Laws.

I am a married women with a large family and circle of friends.

I am a frequent user of a service provider called Jimmy Brings which delivers alcohol, in the evenings, to homes in the Eastern Suburbs. I often entertain at home with my husband, as we prefer the company of our own friends, the sound of our own music and the comfort of our home.

On a number of occasions, we have run out of wine and beer, and have been badly inconvenienced by the 10.00 pm curfew on alcohol home deliveries imposed on Jimmy Brings.

It appears that this curfew occurred as an unintended consequence to the changes in liquor licencing laws.

I believe alcohol delivery can be part of the solution and should not be treated as part of the problem and I urge you to please consider lifting the 10pm cut off for the home delivery of alcohol.
