As a concerned citizen, I am writing to express my opinion that home delivery of alcohol be made exempt from the current ten pm curfew, imposed by the changes to liquor licensing laws in 2014.

I am a DJ and as such, my work demands that I keep late hours. I often return home from work after 10pm, on nights such as these it has been convenient for me to use alcohol delivery services such as Liquor Drop and Jimmy Brings. Since the introduction of the 10pm cut-off I cannot have alcohol delivered to my house if I return home after this hour.

I applaud the government taking steps to reduce alcohol-related violence on Sydney streets however I do not believe that restricting the take away and home delivery sale of alcohol has any bearing on that whatsoever.
