We will not be able to effectively execute our strategy of breaking emerging talent here in Australia, which heavily relies on our artists playing in small bars and late night venues, which seem to be dwindling in numbers since the laws were put into action.

I've seen this city and its nightlife go from being a thriving and vibrant tourist attraction to a soulless and empty city. As a woman and someone who works in Kings Cross during the day and who sometimes would like to have a drink or two after work on a Friday evening, I feel far more safe wandering around at night with other people on the streets than I do walking home along at 1:30 am when there is no-one about.

I urge you to reconsider these laws and action a fair and unbiased review.
