Please reconsider the current lock out laws.

I support the City of Sydney's recommendations, specifically but not limited to -

Well-managed licensed premises should be exempt from the 1.30am lockout, and the 3am "last drinks" rule should be reconsidered. We've also recommended new measures to manage venue growth and concentration, including the introduction of new "saturation zone" rules that consider the number and type of licensed premises in a given area, along with relevant crime data and transport options.

And we are arguing again that liquor licences be granted for set periods, as in cities like New York and Vancouver, and for late-night transport to get people home safely.
