One service I use is the alcohol delivery company, Jimmy Brings. Since the change in licensing laws, this service can no longer deliver past 10pm. I often use this service after coming home from a shoot at night, and now I find that I no longer can.

It baffles me that a company that delivers to people in their own homes has been impacted by laws intended to keep people off the streets. Please consider an exemption for the delivery of alcohol and lift the current curfew.
