To the Hon. Ian Callinan AC,

I write to express my concern on the negative effects of the impacts of the 1.30am lock out and 3am cessation of liquor sales requirements.

The safety and general amenity of the Sydney CBD and surround precincts mentioned in the terms of reference and subject to the Liquor Amendment Act 2014 has become worse under this law. Streets are empty and dangerous to walk at night after the lock out laws. Prior to these timed changes there were places to seek refuge and support and now it is more dangerous and less amenable.

That significant damage to business, commerce, social and cultural life of the city makes the immediate repeal of this act necessary. It is not effective policy.
