My husband and I do enjoy entertaining at home though, and a service we use, Jimmy Brings, has been impacted by the reforms of 2014. As a result of delivery of alcohol being curtailed to 10pm, we can longer use this service past that time.

I am of the belief that entertaining at home can be part of the solution to reducing violent and anti-social behaviour on the streets and any service that facilitates this should be encouraged, not penalised.
