As a 54 year old single mother of two teenage children, these are my suggestions:

Firstly, I think that the drinking laws should be adjusted to only allowing beer to be a legal drink for the 18 to 21 year olds.

After 21 they can then be allowed drink all alcohol legally.

In regard to offences and bad behaviour around drinking...

anyone who causes trouble, gets into fights, and behaves violently under the influence of alcohol in and around the club scene

should be suspended from accessing pubs or clubs for a determined length of time, like one to two years.

It is ridiculous, that the entire community has to suffer restrictions due to the immature and bad behaviour of a minority.

I object to having to drink out of plastic cups. I object to the 1.30am lock out laws and would like to see things open up so that

it isn't so difficult to enjoy a flexible night out of moving from club to club as one wishes.
