I am 34 years old and live in Watson's Bay. I am writing to express my support for Jimmy Brings, a local business I have used many times over the years to deliver alcohol to my home.

Due to the nature of my work, I often return home after 9 or 10pm after filming scenes at night. Often I like to unwind with a glass of wine with my partner, a friend or by myself. Occasionally I return home to find there is no alcohol in the house; it's moments like these that make Jimmy Brings useful as I do not have to get in my car to go the nearest bottle shop and it also means I don't have to go to a bar or pub when all I want is to unwind at home for a few hours before bed.

I believe that Jimmy Brings contribute to a more positive drinking culture through the delivery and responsible service of alcohol to people in the safety of their own homes and ask that you recommend they be exempted from the current 10pm closure.
